Santiam Canyon School District has worked with ZCS Engineering over the past several years. ZCS was initially hired by the District to perform a grant application for seismic retrofit of the gymnasium at Santiam Junior/Senior High School, and the project was funded through the state funding authority. Following funding of the project ZCS was selected through a competitive process to perform the engineering, architecture, and project management for the District.

The gymnasium project was completed over the summer of 2017and the services provided by ZCS were excellent. The project was built within the estimated budget developed at the time of the grant submission and the quality of their work was high. They were mindful of the seismic requirements and integrity of the building, yet also considered function and aesthetics when making decisions.
